LEADERSHIP GIVING OPPORTUNITIES

\$1M - Support research regarding the critical nature of freedom of speech and free press by strengthening development of the James Wright Foley Archives Collection.

The Raynor houses work, letters, notes from captivity, personal mementos and much of the material used in a documentary about James Foley, a 1996 alumnus and late journalist whose defense of conflict journalism resulted in imprisonment, ultimately costing his life while reporting from war-torn Syria in 2014. Reflective of Marquette's mission to prepare women and men to Be The Difference, his legacy calls us to create an endowment to sustain support for a dedicated archivist, appropriate digital and physical preservation, and promotion of this collection.

\$500K-\$1M - Support a Technology Excellence Endowment Fund.

Excellence funds are invaluable for targeted academic needs, the greatest of which in the Raynor is to ensure student access to digital technology and library materials — resources vital to academic excellence and student success. A Technology Excellence Endowment Fund would sustain in perpetuity the purchase and maintenance of:

- Updated technology, including sufficient laptops for checkout.
- Technology that ensures student access to resources through self-service. This is important because staff are not available 24/7, although some areas in the Raynor offer around-the-clock hours.

As described below, immediate-impact gifts can also help provide unhindered access to digital and print materials.

TOP GIVING OPPORTUNITIES

\$125K+ – Support a named Technology Excellence Fund that provides for immediate needs such as the following:

- **\$40K+** To develop digital course texts that students can use free of charge to reduce hidden barriers to learning.
- **\$30K** To purchase a vending/lending machine that ensures students have basic tech items (charging cables, laptops, etc.) whenever needed.
- \$9K To purchase a self-checkout machine that lets students borrow books at all hours.
